OUR 2023 JOURNEY







FEB: Harlandale Students across 13 elementary schools started their 10-week EAB program.

APRIL: We hosted a bike build with Major Taylor Cycling Club at the Davis Scott Family YMCA. 11 students participated and completed our EAB program.





MAY: We hosted a Bike Build with Harlandale ISD. 85 students completed our 10-week program and earned their new bike.

JUN: 30 We partnered with the Harvey E. Najim Family YMCA and led bike rides along Mission Reach for their Summer Camp group. This group rode over 20 miles over the summer.



MILESTONES OF 2023



JUN: 30 students at the Davis Scott Family YMCA learned about bicycle safety, bike maintenance and how to spot and treat heat-related illnesses.

AUG: We hosted a volunteer appreciation event in partnership with Thrivent and TREK San Antonio at Chicken N' Pickle.





SEP: We hosted the first ever EAB 100! 181 participants rode over 12,000 miles to fundraise for EAB programs including Mark Noblitt who cycled 500 miles!

DEC: Our Earn-A-Bike Bike Build event took place at Ella Austin Community Center where 50 students were invited to build their earned bicycles.





EARN-A-BIKE@SCHOOL



On May 7th, students from Harlandale ISD participated in our 10-week Earn-A-Bike @ School program. 89 students successfully completed the program and were invited to the Earn-A-Bike Bike Build hosted at the Harvey E. Najim Family YMCA. These students had to work hard to improve their attendance, decrease negative behaviors and complete all of their EAB coursework in order to earn their spot.





They were guided by their instructors to work through a comprehensive curriculum, which included lessons such as nutrition, bicycle safety, proper helmet use, heat-related illnesses and sustainability.
