Earn-A-Bike (EAB) is a 501(c)(3) organization with a mission to promote active and healthy living amongst San Antonio youth. Since its inception in 2014, the Earn-A-Bike program has promoted cycling, nutrition and environmental sustainability as a path to health by placing more than 4,035 bicycles in the hands of children and adults. Offering after school and free programming at YMCA's across the city, Earn-A-Bike works with schools, community organizations, health institutions, and other partners to ensure that everyone has an equal opportunity to learn the benefits of living active and healthy lives. We target those in underserved areas of San Antonio where disparities often keep youth less physically active.
